



Combe Valley Hospital Taking Shape



We have made great progress during August and the beginning of September.

Not only have we completed the steel frame for the building and started the first internal partitions, we are also working on the pitched roofs and have erected the scaffolding needed for bricklaying to start.

We continue to undertake groundworks and have expanded the car park at the front of the building.

Offsite, capital plant as well as internal doors, are being manufactured and we expect delivery between the end of the year and the start of 2025.

We have also been carrying out maintenance around the ecological areas on the site boundaries. This is to ensure wildlife and surrounding flora and fauna remain protected from the construction works.
